TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Reservations

- **1.** A nonrefundable deposit of U.S. \$500 per person is due at the time of reservation. The balance must be paid by **August 12, 2019** (60 days prior to departure date).
- **2.** Submit the Tour Reservation form along with a copy of the first two pages of your passport (which includes photo and personal information) and full payment to:

Cancellation Policy:

- **a.** For all cancellations or charges, a written notice must be received by mail or e-mail. Failure to comply with deposit and final payment requirement will result in automatic cancellation of your reservation and a penalty fee upon cancellation will apply.
